The cheetah is **faster** than the leopard.



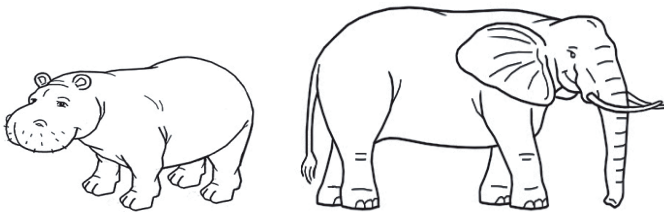
The killer whale is **big**.  
The blue whale is **bigger** than the killer whale.



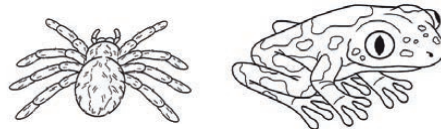
The grasshopper is a **good** jumper.
