TOP PLACES IN NEW YORK

AMERICAN MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY:



At the museum you can learn about dinosaurs, ocean life or space. There is an exhibition on natural disasters like

hurricanes, tornados and earthquakes.

THE EMPIRE STATE BUILDING:



This skyscraper is 381 meters tall and has 103 floors*. There are observatories on both the 86th and 102nd floors

from where you can have a nice view of the city.

THE STATUE OF LIBERTY:



To see the statue you have to go to Liberty Island. The Statue was a present from the people of France and represents the

friendship** between France and the United States. Visitors have to climb 354 stairs to get to the statue's crown***.

CENTRAL PARK:



It is one of the largest and the most visited city parks in the United States. In the park there are lakes, a castle, the

Central Park Zoo and the Metropolitan Museum of Art. There you can have a picnic, play football, read a book under a tree or enjoy the silence in the middle of the city.

TIMES SQUARE:



Famous for its neon lights and colourful signs, Times Square is the perfect place to go shopping. Every year

people come here to celebrate Thanksgiving Day, New Year's Eve, Saint Patrick's Day... Since**** 2011 it is forbidden to smoke in Times Square.

BRONX ZOO:



The zoo has more than 5,000 animals representing about 600 species. You can see zebras, giraffes and lions.

You can also meet lemurs and crocodiles in the permanent *Madagascar!* Exhibition. You can also feed sea lions and penguins.
