**AN-ARCHY DEFINITION**  
"Without Rulers"  
Anarchy does not mean without rules, rather without rulers.

**NON-AGGRESSION PRINCIPLE**  
The unviolated actions of others that physically affect an individual's property, including that person's body, mind, or mind for his own use, are considered actions when they are against the owner's free will and therefore violate his right to self-determination.

**SELF-OWNERSHIP**  
The most basic form of property you own is yourself.

**SELF-DETERMINATION**

**MIGHT MAKES RIGHT**  
Governmental actions can never be the economic and social problems, instead of voluntary peaceful solutions.

**STAT-ISM**  
"A political system in which the state has substantial, established control over social and economic affairs."


**TAXATION**

Taxation goes against the NAP and the principle of self-ownership.




# ANARCHY CHARACTERISTICS

**There is no government at all.**

**Every person is left to fight for themselves.**

**People must continue to live through farming on their own land, find water, and build a home on their own. No one tells you what to do and there is no voting.**

**This type of government usually ends up in people fighting over food, water, land and other things.**

**There is no police to keep the peace.**

# MONARCHY CHARACTERISTICS

**The supreme power is in the hands of a monarch who reigns over a state or territory.**

**The governor rules usually for a life time and by hereditary right.**

**The governor is born into royalty.**

**The governor may be either a sole absolute ruler and is responsible for their country.**

**The governor can also govern with a government voted by the population.**

# **Dictatorship Characteristics**

**Ruling by one party.**

**No or few trials before condemning a person to death and censorship.**

**A supreme ruler controls all the country's power.**

**The decision-making lies with only one person and others do not have any thing to say in the working of the government, it offers a kind of stability to the country.**

# Dictatorship Characteristics

**Problems such as frequent elections, as in the case of democracy, or a disruption of peace due to political factors, do not arise in this type of government.**

# DEMOCRACY CHARACTERISTICS

**Individual liberty.**

**Government works to secure an equal opportunity for people to develop their own abilities.**

**Majority rule with minority rights.**

**Government is based on majority rule through the people's elected representatives, but respects the rights of minorities.**

# DEMOCRACY CHARACTERISTICS

**Free elections.**

**Government is based on free and open elections in which every citizen has the right to vote, every vote has equal weight, and candidates for office can freely express their views.**

**Competing political parties.**

**Political parties choose candidates for office, respect the voters' decisions in elections, and act as loyal opposition.**

# **OLIGARCHY CHARACTERISTICS**

**The group gets its power from military power, social power, wealth, religion or a combination.**

**Political opposition is usually suppressed sometimes violently.**

**Government by the few.**

**The citizen has a very limited role.**

**A small group exercises control, especially for corrupt and selfish purposes.**
