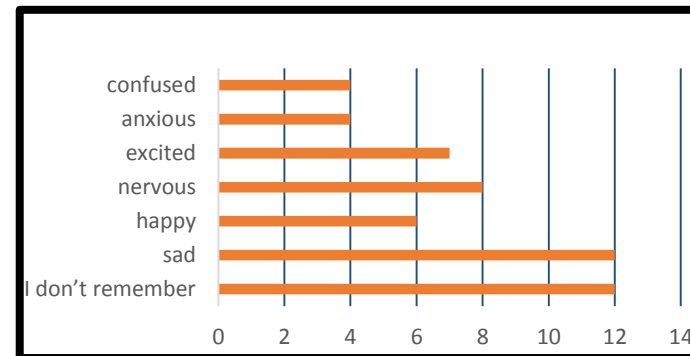

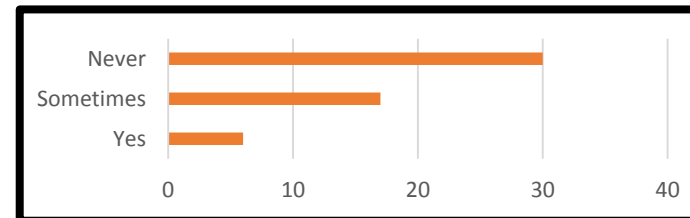
1.- How did you feel the first time you step in the school?

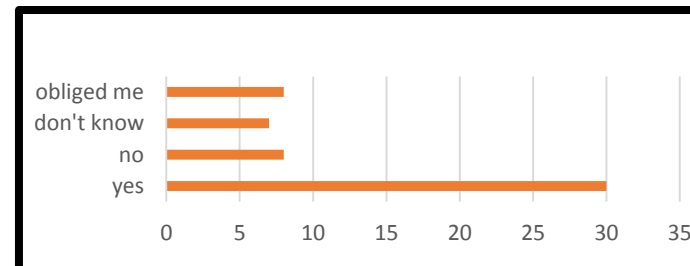
2.- Did you use to skip many classes?

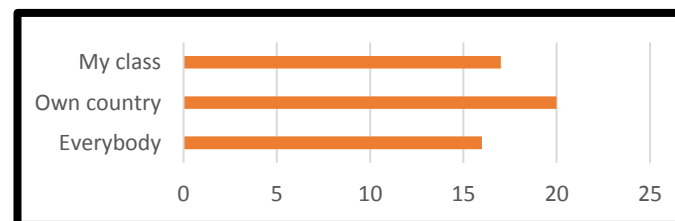

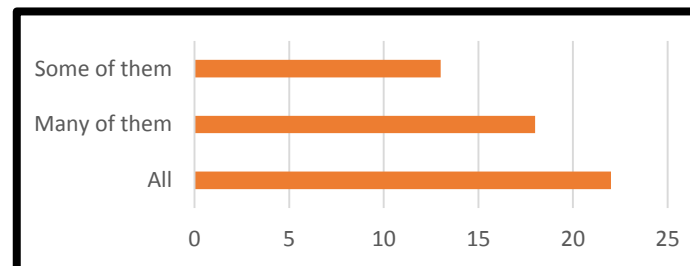

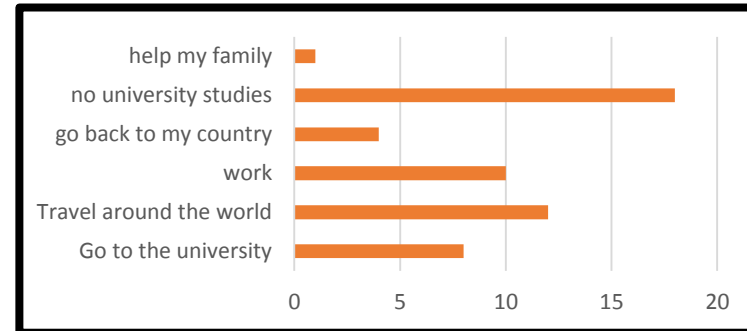

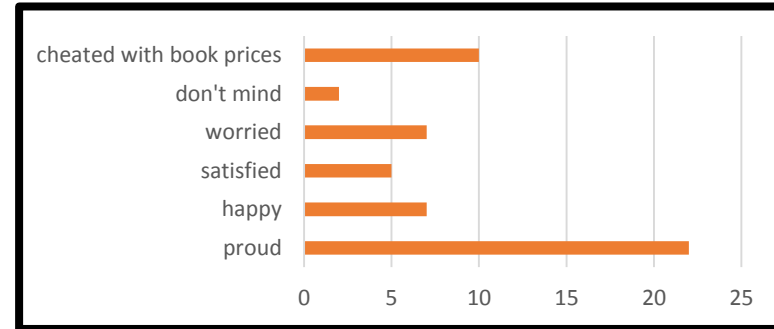
