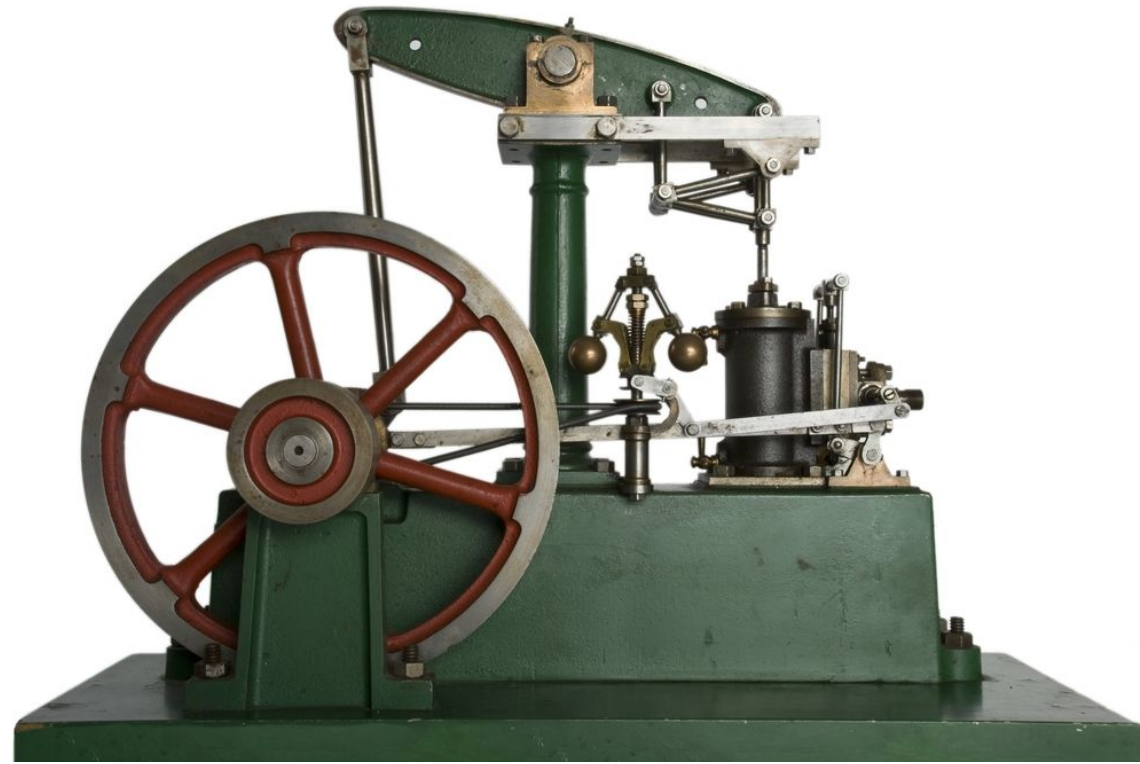
Printing press (1440)

- For **printing**.
- It makes many **copies** of **identical** pages.
- It is used to print **books** and **newspapers**.



Steam engine (1633)

- It uses **steam** from boiling water to make it move.
- They can power many kinds of machines including **vehicles (Steam locomotive)**



Typewriter (1829)

- For **typing** on a piece of paper instead of writing by hand.
- It has keys for typing **letters**, **numbers**, and **symbols**.
- The earliest typing: stone, clay, or metal sheets.



Light bulb (1880)

- It produces **light** from **electricity**.
- Billions are in use, some even in outer space.



Telephone (1876)

- **Communication tool**
- Using it two people who are in **different places** can talk to each other.
- Modern mobile phones use **radio waves**.



Computer (1936)

- Device for working with **information**.
- People use them **every day** at work, at school, and at home.
- For sending e-mail, searching for information, writing reports, playing games...
