This is mistletoe. It grows on tree branches. The plant is a parasite. It takes water and nutrients from the tree. But mistletoe is important because many birds and mammals eat it.



This bird is called a woodpecker because it pecks tree trunks. It makes holes in the trunk. Its babbles live in the hole. Woodpeckers eat insects that live in trees.



Some mushrooms grow on the trunks, but don't eat them. Some of them are poisonous.



Squirrels live in nests in trees. They build their nest high in the tree for protection from predators. Their favourite food is nuts.



These beetles lay their eggs in dead trees. When the larvae are born, they eat the dead Wood.
