This is a crab. It's walking **sideways** and it's looking for food.

There are more than 4,500 **species** of crabs.

Most species live in coastal areas of **salty**, fresh or brackish water.



This is seaweed. Lots of Little fish are hiding in the seaweed.

Most of the world's oxygen (about 70%) comes from seaweeds and other microscopic **algae**. It comes in many **shapes** and **sizes**



This is a starfish; it's resting in the rock pool. It's safe from the **waves**. They usually have five arms.

They cannot survive in fresh water.



This is a sea urchin. It's got sharp **spikes**. Be careful not to touch it.

Main enemies of sea urchins are otters, sea birds, fish, crabs, and humans.



This is a little seahorse; it's swimming in the rock pool.

Seahorses prefer to swim in pairs with their tails **linked** together. Except for crabs, few marine **predators** eat the seahorse. It is too **bony** and indigestible.
