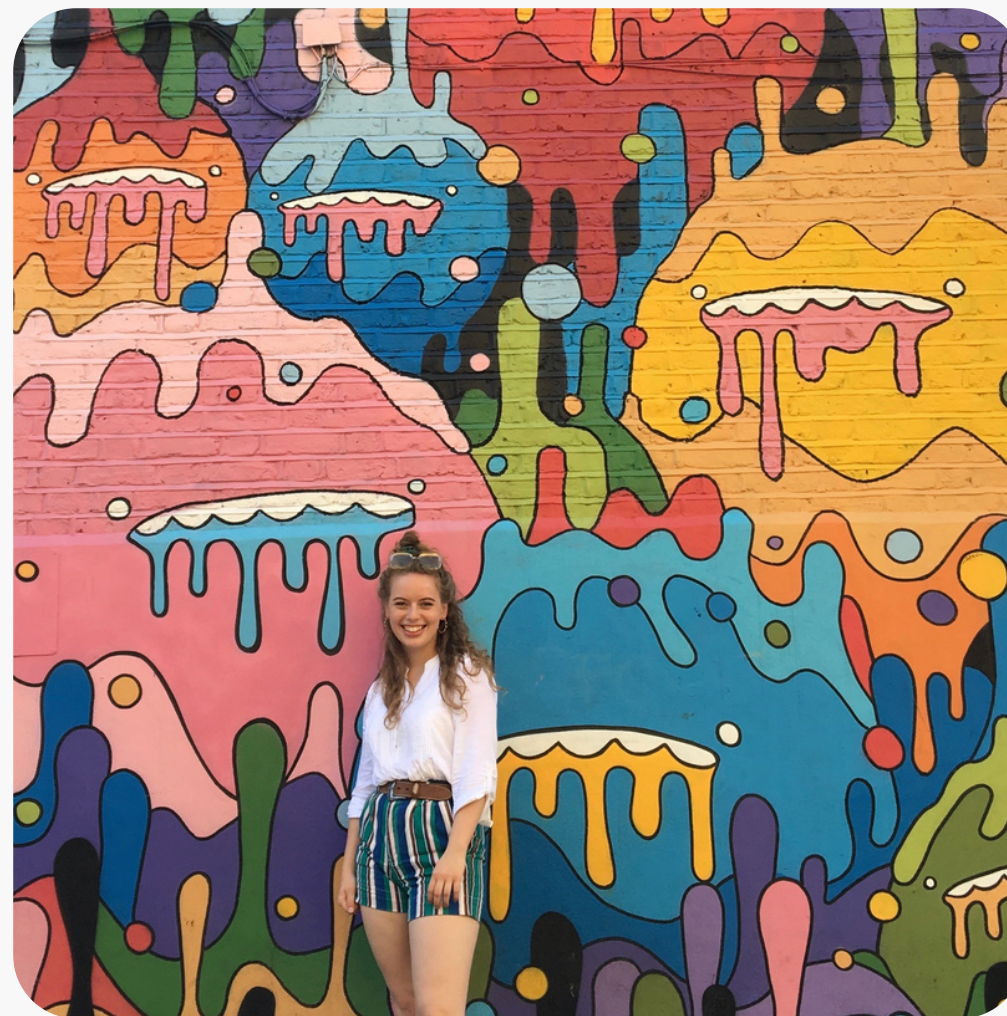
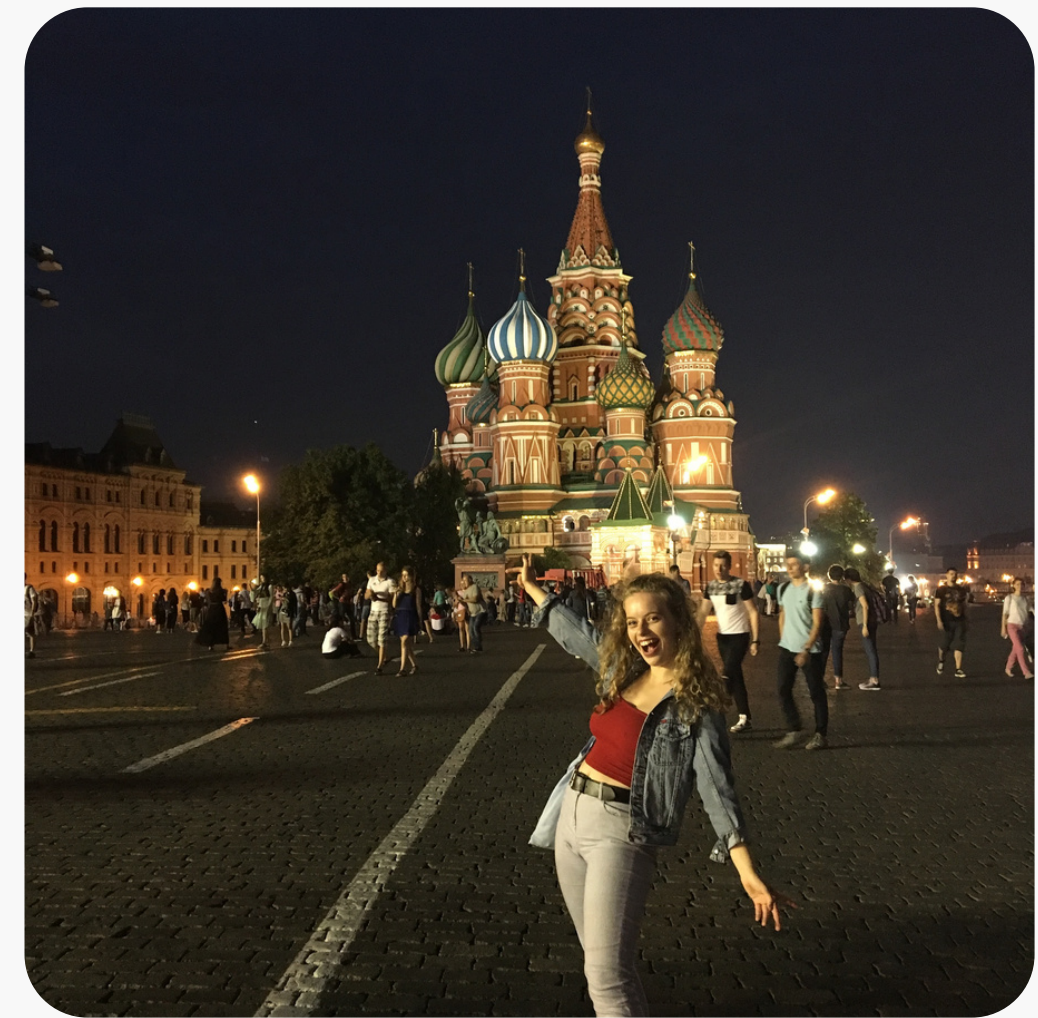

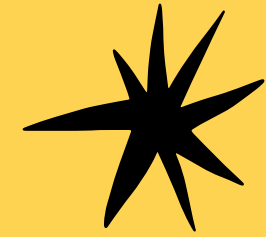
WHAT I LOVE
