# No more boring stopovers go on a guided tour!

Few things are more depressing than spending hours in an airport terminal waiting for a connecting flight.



Emmanuel Rozenblum and Anna Veyrenc launched their business in Paris

There you are, sitting in the departure lounge watching the clock, or <sup>1</sup> ... And the most frustrating thing is that outside the airport there is a foreign city which you'd really like to look around, full of great

05 tourist attractions, restaurants, and shops. But you don't want to leave the airport, because 2\_\_\_ miss your flight.

'We left the airport on our own,' says Mr Rozenblum, 'but we didn't know which bus to take, and

They caught their flight, and 5 . Millions of 15 air travellers make stopovers every year, so Emmanuel thought he could organize short guided trips into the nearest city or countryside.

His idea is that a guide picks up the travellers at the airport, takes them quickly around the sights and to a 20 restaurant, and then 6


