For the students in 4th, 5th and 6th grades

- Record a video, or audio explaining your new daily routines. Remember to say the times. For example: I wake up at nine o'clock in the morning, then I have breakfast at...
- Take a picture or video from your window or balcony at home and explain what you can see. Use the structure **There is /isn't** or **There are/aren't**. For example: There is a big park. In the park there are a lot of trees. There isn't a mountain but there is a street...
- There are a lot of new rules now that people must follow. Record a video or audio explaining all the things that you must and mustn't do at home, and things that we **must** and **mustn't** do outside in the street or supermarket. For example: At home I must go to sleep before half past eleven and I must wake up at nine o'clock. I must wash my hands. We mustn't go outside if it isn't necessary, we mustn't touch anyone ...
