Johnny Appleseed was an American pioneer nurseryman who introduced apple trees to large parts of Pennsylvania, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, and present-day Ontario, as well as the northern counties of present-day West Virginia.

**Born: September 26, 1774, Leominster, MA**

**Died: March 18, 1845, Fort Wayne, IN**

**Place of burial: Johnny Appleseed Park, Fort Wayne, IN**

**Known for: Proliferation of orchards throughout the American frontier**

**Siblings: Nathaniel Chapman, Jonathan Cooley, Persis Chapman**

**Parents: Elizabeth Simonds, Nathaniel Chapman**

**Other names: Appleseed, First environmentalist.**
