

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Aspects to be taken into account:

The school doors will be opened for ten minutes, from 8:25 am to 8:35 am and from 2:55 pm to 3:05 pm, in order to give the pupils enough time to enter without any overcrowding. The doors will be closed again five minutes after the above times.

Pupils who arrive after the doors have been closed will not be allowed to enter the centre directly and will have to wait in the hallway until they are met by the caretaker. They will be accompanied by an adult if they are in any of the groups from P3 to the 2nd form and they will be taken to their classrooms once they have washed their hands.

Each of the communities will enter and leave the school independently.

The smaller children community (P3, P4, P5 and 1st form)

They will enter and leave through the door in Àngel Guimerà Street. They will queue up in front of the door the appropriate distance apart and enter when the door is opened. They will gradually enter as they arrive.

The intermediate-age community (2nd, 3rd and 4th forms)

They will enter through the playground door in 3 de Abril Avenue. The pupils should stay close to the wall as they enter and, before they do, queue up on the pavement to the right of the door, next to the wall of the building.

The older children community (5th and 6th forms and 1st secondary form)

They will enter through the door in 3 de Abril Avenue (ramp). The pupils should not access the ramp until the school door has been opened, thus avoiding any overcrowding.

Teenage community (2nd, 3rd and 4th secondary forms)

They will enter through the door in 3 de Abril Avenue, just like the intermediate-age community. They should enter across the court in the playground so as not to mix with the intermediate-age community pupils. They should queue up to the left of the door before they enter.

The teachers should also enter and leave through the door corresponding to their community.

REMEMBER: We must respect the safety distance at all times and we can't enter the school without wearing a face mask.

Overcrowding must be avoided when the pupils arrive and leave, so they should arrive at the school in good time for them to be dropped off and picked up.

There will be a volunteer at each of the school doors to ensure that the safety measures are complied with. We must do everything to make their task as easy as possible.

VERY IMPORTANT! When your children are self-confining or waiting for PCR results (as members of a stable group or due to personal or family situations) **THEY MUST NOT GO OUT ONTO THE STREET OR GO TO THE SCHOOL TO PICK UP THEIR BROTHERS AND SISTERS OR FOR ANY OTHER REASON** until their self-confinement is over and they have been free of symptoms for 72 hours.

It is also essential for them to abide by the measures recommended by the health service during their period of self-confinement at home. remaining in an isolated room, separate cleaning of kitchen utensils, etc.
