

Burlington English Conference in 4tESO

A few minutes ago, in the library of the high school, there was a conference about the English language. One "teacher" named Thor gave the presentation and explained many important aspects of British English, focusing mainly on topics related to horror and spooky stories. For instance, he talked in detail about famous literary characters, such as Dracula, Frankenstein, and other well-known figures. Additionally, he covered important language concepts, including homonyms, synonyms, and the use of -ing verbs. The conference was both educational and entertaining.
