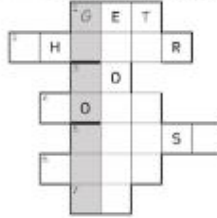

Visit exciting Peru

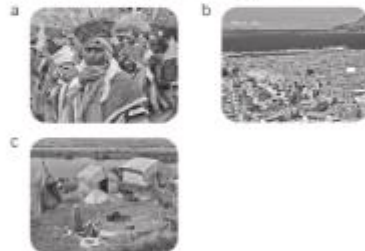
Day 1
