

The Institut de Nàutica de Barcelona will select the students with the best academic marks and the best attitude and maturity to carry out the mobility. Meetings will also be made to find out the motivation of the students. Once there is a call in progress, candidates must fill in:

- 1.- The application "full de sol·licitud de l'alumne": where you want to participate in the Erasmus scholarships call
- 2.- Motivation letter (if it is possible in the language of the country of destination)
- 3.- Europass curriculum (if it is possible in the language of the country of destination)

And send the 3 documents to the Department of Mobility mail. Once all the nominations have been received, the candidates will be ranked according to the call.

We can currently offer 2 calls:

Fundació BarcelonaFP call: the center must choose 3 GM candidates (in total 3 from the different GM specialties) and 3 GS candidates (in total 3 from the different GS specialties).

To rate the different candidates, the Institute assesses section D (letter of motivation) and E (assessment of the teaching team). Once the candidates arrive at the BCNFP Foundation, the candidates have to bring their CV in Europass format and they are interviewed in English, and the Foundation just chooses from these 3 candidates.

Call Department Education: The center evaluates the different candidates from the 5 sections (A, B, C, D and E).

Assess

The evaluation will be carried out by the coordinator of European programs in collaboration with the teaching team of the candidates and the specialist teacher of languages.

- a. Academic marks: 20 points. Students with the best academic record will have priority.
- b. Knowledge of the language: 20 points
- c. CV (if it is possible in the language of mobility): 10 points.
- d. Motivation letter (if it is possible in the language of mobility): 20 points
- e. Evaluation of the teaching team: 40 points. The teaching team of each student will take into account attendance, punctuality, responsibility, degree of maturity, relationship with classmates and with the teaching staff depending on their attitude in the classrooms and workshops at the center.

The candidates admitted in each call will be published on the center's website, and its subsequent evaluation.

You must have a minimum of 50 points to be eligible for mobility.

Priority will be the candidate with the highest score. In the event of a tie, priority will be given to the second-year candidate
