<b>01. Organization</b>	<p><b>Format is excellent. The e-postcard begins with <i>hi</i> or similar, has three paragraphs and finishes with <i>see you</i> or similar and the name of the author.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>2 points</b></p>	<p>Format is correct. Only one of the following parts is missing: salutation, three paragraphs, <i>see you</i> or similar and the name of the author.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>1.5 points</b></p>	<p>Format is poor. Two of the following parts are missing: salutation, three paragraphs, <i>see you</i> or similar and the name of the author.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>1 point</b></p>	<p>Format is unacceptable. Three or more of the following parts are missing: salutation, three paragraphs, <i>see you</i> or similar and the name of the author.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>0.5-0 points</b></p>
<b>02. Sentence structure and grammar</b>	<p><b>All sentences are well constructed and have varied structure and length. The author makes no errors in grammar. The author uses present perfect and past simple correctly.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>3 points</b></p>	<p>Most sentences are well constructed and have varied structure and length. The author makes a few errors in grammar, but they do not interfere with understanding. The uses present perfect and past simple correctly.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>2 points</b></p>	<p>Most sentences are well constructed, but they have a similar structure and/or length. The author makes several errors in grammar that interfere with understanding. The author makes some mistakes with present perfect and past simple.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>1 point</b></p>	<p>Sentences are repetitive or difficult to understand. The author makes numerous errors in grammar that interfere with understanding. The author does not use present perfect and past simple correctly.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>0.5-0 points</b></p>
<b>03. Content</b>	<p><b>Body includes three complete paragraphs. In the first paragraph the author says where he/she is and what kind of holiday it has been so far. In paragraph 2 the author describes the things he/she has done and one particular day in detail. In paragraph 3 the author describes something he/she hasn't done and why not.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>3 points</b></p>	<p>Body includes three paragraphs. The information is not well-distributed in the paragraphs. Some information are missing.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>2 points</b></p>	<p>Body includes three paragraphs. The information does not follow a coherent order. Some information is missing.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>1 point</b></p>	<p>Body doesn't include three paragraphs. The writer doesn't give news about him/herself. Lots of information is missing.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>0.5-0 points</b></p>
<b>05. Vocabulary and spelling</b>	<p><b>The writer uses a variety of words and the choice and placement of the words seems accurate, natural and not forced. There aren't any spelling mistakes.</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>2 point</b></p>	<p>The writer uses a variety of words, but occasionally the words are used inaccurately. There are a few (1 or 2) spelling mistakes, but they do not interfere with understanding.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>1.5 points</b></p>	<p>The writer uses words that communicate clearly, but the writing lacks variety. There are several (3 or 4) spelling mistakes that interfere with understanding.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>1 point</b></p>	<p>The writer uses a limited vocabulary that does not communicate strongly or capture the reader's interest. There are several (more than 4) spelling mistakes that interfere with understanding.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>0.5-0 points</b></p>
