

SPEAKING – Talking about photos

01. Content	<p>The student describes the photo in an accurate way. He/she says what the people are doing using present continuous and where they are in the photo using the expressions <i>on the right/left, in the middle, at the back/front, in the foreground, at the top/bottom...</i> He/she talks about how they look using the expressions <i>look like + noun/person, look + adjective and look as though/as if/like + clause.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;">3 points</p>	<p>The student is able to describe the photo in a quite good way. He/she talks about what the people are doing, where they are in the photo and how they look. He/she makes just 1 mistake with the expressions learned in class.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2 points</p>	<p>The student can describe the photo, but he/she makes some mistakes (2 or 3) with the expressions learned in class. He/she forgets to say one of these things: what the people are doing, where they are in the photo and how they look</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1 points</p>	<p>The student has problems to describe the photo. He/she makes several mistakes (more than 3) with the expressions learned in class. He/she forgets to say two of these things: what the people are doing, where they are in the photo and how they look.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">0 – 0.5 points</p>
02. Fluency	<p>The student speaks smoothly, with little hesitation that does not interfere with communication at all.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2 points</p>	<p>The student speaks with some hesitation, but it doesn't usually interfere with communication.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1.5 points</p>	<p>The student speaks with some hesitation, which often interferes with communication.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1 points</p>	<p>The student hesitates too often when speaking, which often interferes with communication.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">0 – 0.5 points</p>
03. Grammar and vocabulary	<p>All the sentences used are grammatically correct. The Student uses a variety of words and the choice and placement of the words seems accurate, natural and not forced. He/she shows a very good knowledge of the vocabulary related to clothes and fashion.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">3 points</p>	<p>Most of the sentences used are grammatically correct. There is just one mistake, but it does not interfere with understanding. The student uses a variety of words, but occasionally the words are used inaccurately. He/she shows a good knowledge of the vocabulary related to clothes and fashion.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2 points</p>	<p>The student makes several errors in grammar (2 or 3) that interfere with understanding. He/she uses words that communicate clearly, but the speech lacks variety. He/she doesn't show a good knowledge of the vocabulary related to clothes and fashion.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1 points</p>	<p>The student makes frequent errors (more than 3). Most of the sentences used have important mistakes that interfere with understanding. He/she uses a limited vocabulary that does not communicate strongly. He/she doesn't know the vocabulary related to clothes and fashion.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">0 – 0.5 points</p>

04. Pronunciation	Pronunciation and intonation are almost always very clear/accurate.	Pronunciation and intonation are usually clear/accurate, with just a few mistakes.	Pronunciation and intonation errors sometimes make it difficult to understand the student.	Frequent problems with pronunciation and intonation
