History of the Riera river

During the night of September 25, 1962, in two hours an intense rain of more than 200 l/m2 fell on the Serra de l'Obac and Sant Llorenç del Munt, which caused an increase in the flow of the streams of Palau and de Rubí, affecting the towns of Terrassa, Les Fonts and Rubí. Hundreds of people died and many houses and factories were destroyed.
