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Why this document

The purpose of this document is to present the Institute Montsià and our willingness to participate in international mobility projects with the aim to enable our students to perform practical work internships in companies of European countries .



Who we are

The Institut Montsià is a public center for Vocational Education depending on the Department d'Educació de la Generalitat de Catalunya, where they are given courses of Initial Vocational Education and Training (Formació Professional Bàsica), Secondary Vocational Education and Training (Formació Professional de Grau Mitjà), Short Cycle Tertiary Education- Higher Professional Education (Formació Professional de Grau Superior).

As a collaborating center of the area of Active Policies of the City of Amposta we also impart non-formal education: occupational courses.

The Institute obtains the ISO 9001 certification in June 2004 (company ECA) and the recognition of excellence for certification e2Cat during 12/13 (assessed in July 2012). We have documented proof of being Green School since June 2006, have assessment and recognition of learning services, and course 13/14 started to teach vocational education with DUAL system.

The Institut Montsia as an organization qualified for excellence is recognized not only by the results of education, but also by customer and staff satisfaction, because they enjoy a good reputation and the fact of having a positive impact on the community in which we operate.

A training center able to continuously improve of the personal, comprehensive and academic development of students, open to exchange and learning at national and international level that allows us to improve in the teaching - learning of foreign languages.

The Institute Montsia has awarded the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) for the period 2014-2020.

We have been doing international mobility since 2008, and we have partners in United Kingdom, Italy, France and Germany.



Where we are

The Institute Montsià is located in the town of Amposta, a town of about 20,000 inhabitants located in the south of Catalonia, on the right bank of the river Ebro and capital of Montsià county.

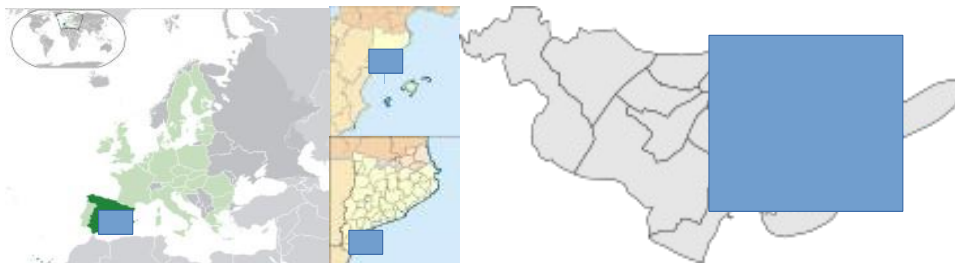
The main sector of the economy of the town was until recently agriculture, especially rice cultivation and irrigation and related activities such as machinery.

Currently the economy is more diversified. Agriculture continues to exist, but the loss of profitability and the mechanization of the field have reduced the number of people employed. The Cambra Arroquera del Montsià (Montsià Rice Chamber) is one of the largest cooperatives in Spain and Catalonia's largest, is also one of the most important companies in the city.

The industry has come to occupy an important place in the economy. The workshop was the traditional industry machinery, paper industry and food but in recent years these sectors have developed tremendously and new industries have emerged as part of the furniture in the metal and construction.

The service sector is highly developed, and the city is an important center not only for the Montsia county services, but embraces other locations outside the region. It has the services of a capital region and head of judicial party, some delegations of the Government and is part of the mall and has a growing tourism sector related to Delta del Ebro Natural Park and the coast.
